Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.80 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 25, slightly up from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 25, was 4.82 million, down 10 percent from the previous week but up 37 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 25, up 1 percent from the week prior but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 25, was 14.6 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but down 1 percent from the previous year.
