Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.49 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 24, up slightly from the week prior but down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 24, was 3.58 million, down 10 percent from the previous week and down 31 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 24, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 24, was 14.6 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.
