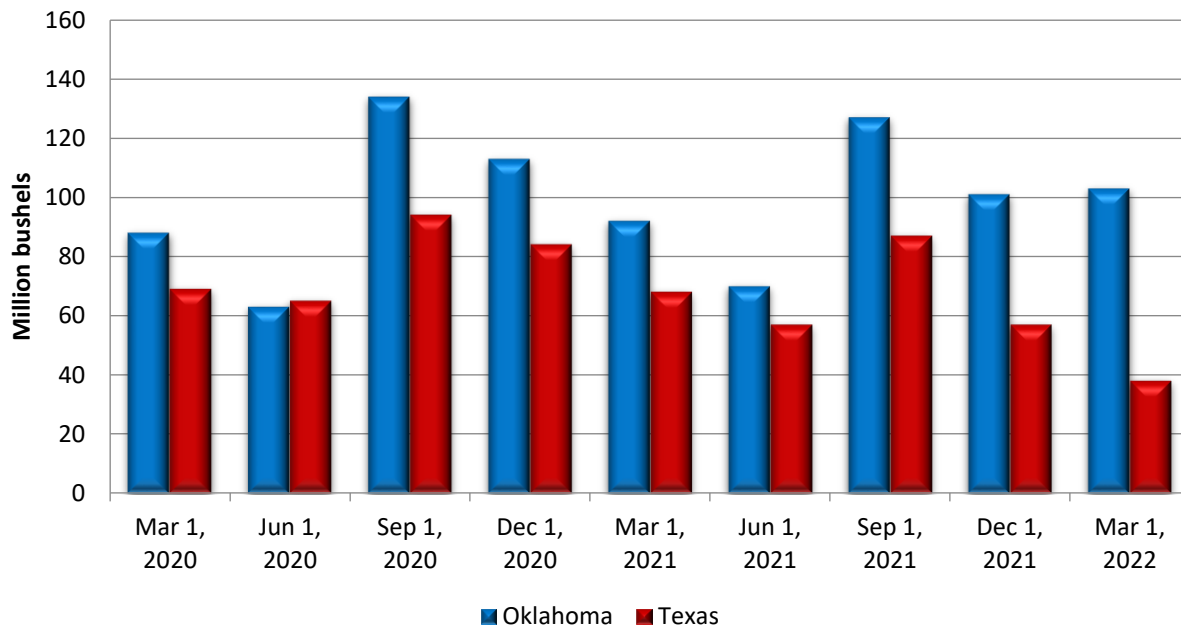

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of March. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on June 30, 2022.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1 totaled 103 million bushels, up 13 percent from the 2021 level of 91.8 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 101 million bushels, were 13 percent higher than March 1, 2021.

Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1, at 38.1 million bushels, were down 44 percent from the 2021 level of 67.9 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 36.8 million bushels, were 44 percent lower than March 1, 2021.

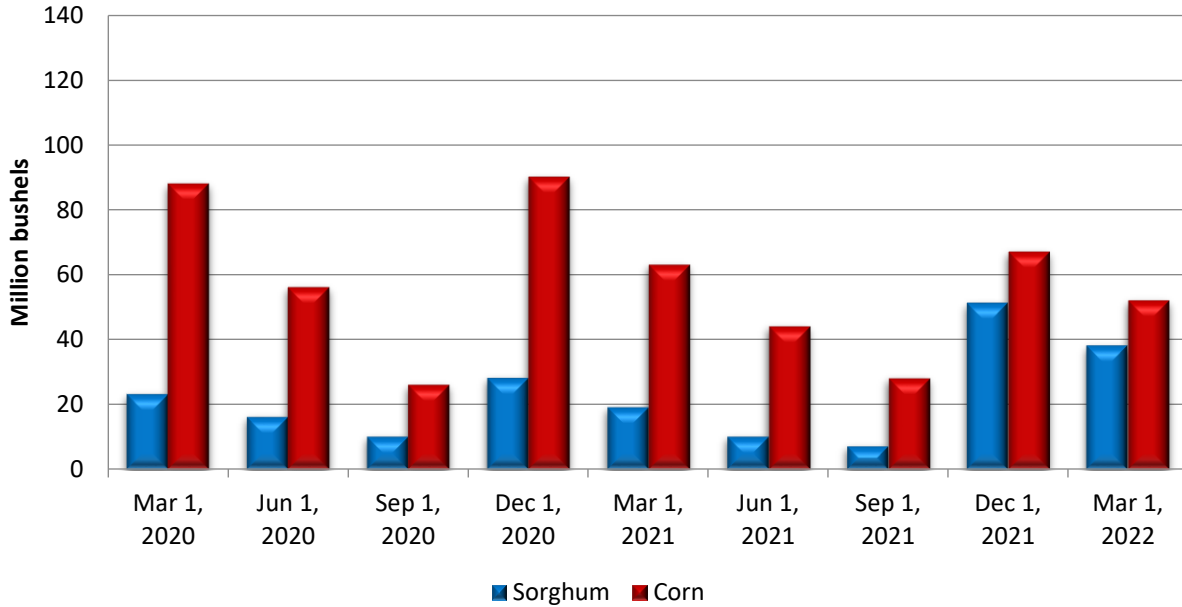
Quarterly Wheat Stocks All Positions



Texas off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 38.4 million bushels. On-farm stocks for sorghum totaled 1.00 million bushels on March 1, 2022.

Texas off-farm corn stocks, at 52.5 million bushels, were down 17 percent from last year. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

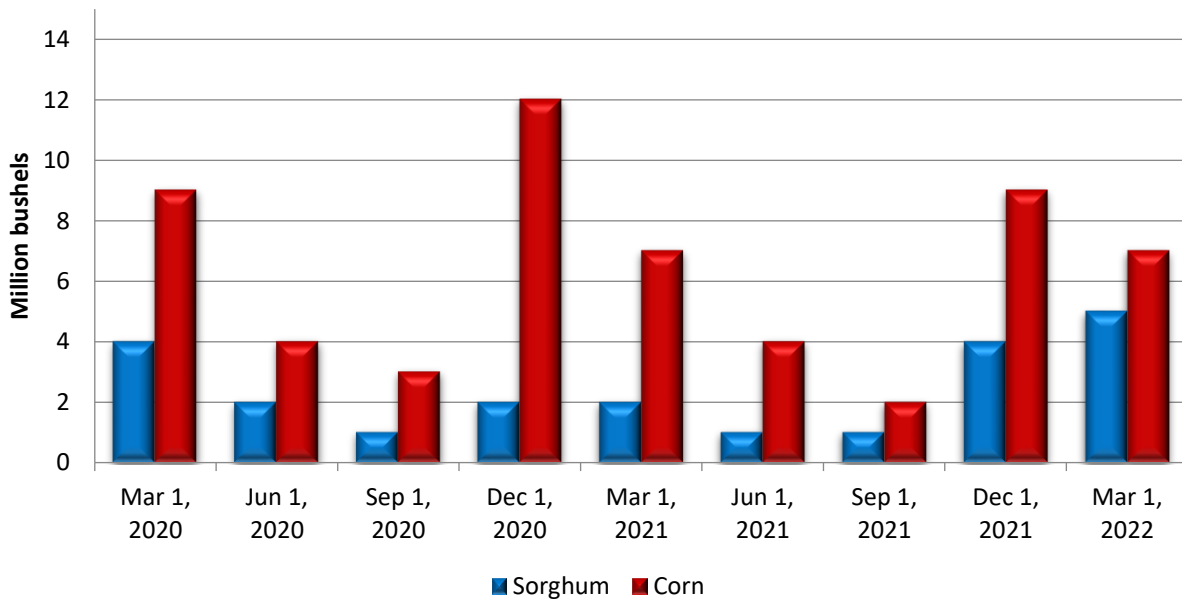
**Texas Quarterly Stocks

Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 5.10 million bushels, up 220 percent March 1, 2021. On-farm stocks for sorghum are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm corn stocks, at 6.93 million bushels, were up 2 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

U.S. Highlights: Total stocks of corn in the United States on March 1, 2022 were 7.85 billion bushels, 2 percent higher than March 1, 2021. All wheat stocks were estimated at 1.02 billion bushels in all positions, down 22 percent from last March. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 207 million bushels, 51 percent above March 1, 2021. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 1.93 billion bushels, up 24 percent from last year.
