Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.36 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 6, up slightly from the week prior but down 14 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 6, was 3.81 million, down 12 percent from the previous week and down 20 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 6, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 6, was 14.6 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.
