Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.47 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 10, up slightly from the week prior but down 27 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 10, was 3.89 million, up 1 percent from the previous week but down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 10, down 4 percent from the week prior but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 10, was 14.4 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 7 percent from the previous year.
