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January 1 Sheep and Lamb Inventory in the Northwest Region Down 3 Percent from Last Year

January 1, 2023 sheep and lamb inventory in Idaho was estimated at 220,000 head, down 4 percent from 2022. Inventory of sheep and lambs in Oregon was 140,000 head, down 3 percent from last year. In Washington, sheep and lamb inventory totaled 52,000 head, up 4 percent from January 1, 2022. Nationally, all sheep and lamb inventory was estimated at 5.02 million head on January 1, 2023. This was down 1 percent from January 1, 2022.


January 1, 2023 milk goat inventory in Idaho totaled 6,400 head, up 2 percent from 2022. Inventory of milk goats in Oregon was estimated at 12,500 head, up 6 percent from last year. In Washington, milk goat inventory was 7,200 head, up 7 percent from the previous year. Nationally, January 1, 2023 milk goat inventory was estimated at 400,000 head, down 2 percent from January 1, 2022.

January 1, 2023 inventory of meat and other goats in Oregon was estimated at 27,000 head, up 4 percent from last year. In Washington, meat and other goat inventory was 22,500 head, up 2 percent from the previous year. Nationally, January 1, 2023 meat and other goat inventory was estimated at 2.0 million head, down 1 percent from January 1, 2022.

All goat inventory in the United States on January 1, 2023, totaled 2.51 million head, down 2 percent from 2022.




