

Agricultural Exports, 2003

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
Pennsylvania: U.S. agricultural exports from the Keystone State during the fiscal year (FY) October 2002-September 2003 were valued at \$1,012.3 million. This represents an increase of 6 percent from the \$955.0 million worth of commodities exported in FY 2002.

Pennsylvania exports ranked sixth in dairy products; seventh in unmanufactured tobacco; eighth in poultry and products; ninth in hides and skins, and fats and oils; eleventh in prepared fruits; and twelfth in live animals and meat.

United States: The value of agricultural exports for the U.S. during FY 2003 totaled \$56.2 billion, up 5 percent from the \$53.3 billion in FY 2002.

California was the leading export state in FY 2003. The total value of their exports was \$8.2 billion. Other leading states and their value were: Iowa, \$3.6 billion; Illinois, \$3.4 billion; Texas, \$3.4 billion; Nebraska, \$3.0 billion; and Kansas, \$3.0 billion.

Methodology: The Economic Research Service estimates State export shares based primarily on production share of the commodity. The estimated export value for each State should not be interpreted as actual measurements of a State's exports. An agricultural commodity is likely to pass through several States before being exported, little data exists on shipments between States, and the State origin is lost as commodities move from farmgate to port.
