Several assumptions are made to convert haylage and greenchop to a dry equivalent. Haylage production is based on haylage weight at harvest and then converted to dry equivalent production. ³ All Forage is the sum of the following dry equivalents: a) alfalfa hay harvested as **dry hay**, b) all other hay harvested as **dry hay**, c) alfalfa haylage and greenchop, d) all other hay haylage and greenchop.
