Pennsylvania 2018 Annual Milk Production Down 2.1 Percent from 2017

HARRISBURG, PA - The annual production of milk for Pennsylvania during 2018 was 10.7 billion pounds, 2.1 percent below 2017, according to King Whetstone, Regional Director of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office.

Production per cow in Pennsylvania averaged 20,549 pounds for 2018, 200 pounds below 2017.

The average number of milk cows on farms in Pennsylvania during 2018 was 519 thousand head, down 6,000 head from 2017.
