



NORTHEASTERN REGION MONTHLY MILK PRODUCTION REPORT

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Milk production in **New York** during September 2019 totaled 1.23 billion pounds, up 1.7 percent from September 2018. The average milk price received by New York farmers in August 2019, at \$19.10 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from July 2019 and up \$2.70 from August a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during September 2019 totaled 800 million pounds, down 3.8 percent from September 2018. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in August 2019, at \$19.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from July 2019 and up \$3.00 from August a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during September 2019 totaled 218 million pounds, up 0.5% from September 2018. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in August 2019, at \$19.50 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from July 2019 and up \$2.80 from August a year ago.
