Milk production in **New York** during April 2020 totaled 1.29 billion pounds, up 1.5 percent from April 2019. The average milk price received by New York farmers in March 2020, at \$18.50 per hundredweight, is down \$0.60 from February 2020 but up \$0.20 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during April 2020 totaled 883 million pounds, up 1.6 percent from April 2019. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in March 2020, at \$18.90 per hundredweight, is down \$0.50 from February 2020 but up \$0.40 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during April 2020 totaled 223 million pounds, down 1.8 percent from April 2019. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in March 2020, at \$19.00 per hundredweight, is down \$0.60 from February 2020 but up \$0.30 from March a year ago.
