Milk production in **New York** during February 2020 totaled 1.22 billion pounds, up 5.5 percent from February 2019. The average milk price received by New York farmers in January 2020, at \$19.80 per hundredweight, is down \$0.70 from December 2019 but up \$2.30 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during February 2020 totaled 833 million pounds, up 3.7 percent from February 2019. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in January 2020, at \$20.20 per hundredweight, is down \$0.70 from December 2019 but up \$2.50 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during February 2020 totaled 214 million pounds, up 1.9 percent from February 2019. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2020, at \$20.30 per hundredweight, is down \$0.50 from December 2019 but up \$2.40 from January a year ago.
