Milk production in **New York** during January 2020 totaled 1.29 billion pounds, up 2.2 percent from January 2018. The average milk worth received by New York farmers in December 2019, at \$20.50 per hundredweight, is unchanged from November 2019 but up \$3.10 from December a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during January 2020 totaled 866 million pounds, down 0.8 percent from January 2018. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in December 2019, at \$20.90 per hundredweight, is down \$0.10 from November 2019 but up \$3.30 from December a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during January 2020 totaled 226 million pounds, down 1.7 percent from January 2018. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in December 2019, at \$20.80 per hundredweight, is down \$0.10 from November 2019 but up \$3.00 from December a year ago.
