Milk production in **New York** during November 2020 totaled 1.24 billion pounds, up 2.1 percent from November 2019. The average milk price received by New York farmers in October 2020, at \$18.80 per hundredweight, is up \$0.80 from September 2020 but down \$0.90 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during November 2020 totaled 815 million pounds, up 0.9 percent from November 2019. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in October 2020, at \$18.80 per hundredweight, is up \$0.80 from September 2020 and \$1.40 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during November 2020 totaled 207 million pounds, down 3.3 percent from November 2019. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in October 2020, at \$19.20 per hundredweight, is up \$0.90 from September 2020 but down \$0.80 from October a year ago.
