Milk production in **New York** during February 2021 totaled 1.20 billion pounds, down 1.8 percent from February 2020. The average milk price received by New York farmers in January 2021, at \$17.10 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from December 2020 and down \$2.70 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during February 2021 totaled 798 million pounds, down 4.2 percent from February 2020. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in January 2021, at \$17.30 per hundredweight, is down \$1.50 from December 2020 and down \$2.90 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during February 2021 totaled 199 million pounds, down 7.0 percent from February 2020. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2021, at \$17.80 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from December 2020 and down \$2.50 from January a year ago.
