Milk production in **New York** during March 2021 totaled 1.33 billion pounds, up 0.5 percent from March 2020. The average milk price received by New York farmers in February 2021, at \$17.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.30 from January 2021 but down \$1.70 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during March 2021 totaled 893 million pounds, down 1.5 percent from March 2020. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in February 2021, at \$17.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from January 2021 but down \$2.00 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during March 2021 totaled 222 million pounds, down 4.3 percent from March 2020. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in February 2021, at \$17.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from January 2021 but down \$1.70 from February a year ago.
