Milk production in **New York** during May 2022 totaled 1.36 billion pounds, unchanged from May 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in April 2022, at \$27.10 per hundredweight, is up \$1.20 from March 2022 but up \$8.80 from a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during May 2022 totaled 883 million pounds, down 1.1 percent from May 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in April 2022, at \$27.50 per hundredweight, is up \$1.10 from March 2022 but up \$9.10 from a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during May 2022 totaled 221 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from May 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in April 2022, at \$27.70 per hundredweight, is up \$1.10 from March 2022 but up \$8.80 from a year ago.
