Milk production in **New York** during October 2022 totaled 1.31 billion pounds, up 1.7 percent from October 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in September 2022, at \$26.00 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from August 2022 and up \$7.10 from September a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during October 2022 totaled 826 million pounds, up 1.0 percent from October 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in September 2022, at \$26.10 per hundredweight, is down \$0.10 from August 2022 but up \$7.10 from September a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during October 2022 totaled 212 million pounds, up 0.5 percent from October 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in September 2022, at \$26.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from August 2022 and up \$7.00 from September a year ago.
