Milk production in **New York** during December 2023 totaled 1.34 billion pounds, up 1.4 percent from December 2022. The average milk price received by New York farmers in November 2023, at \$23.20 per hundredweight, is unchanged from October 2023 but \$2.80 lower than November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during December 2023 totaled 821 million pounds, down 0.8 percent from December 2022. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in November 2023, at \$23.10 per hundredweight, is \$0.30 higher than October 2023 but \$3.50 lower than November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during December 2023 totaled 209 million pounds, down 2.3 percent from December 2022. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in November 2023, at \$23.60 per hundredweight, is \$0.10 higher than October 2023 but \$2.70 lower than November a year ago.
