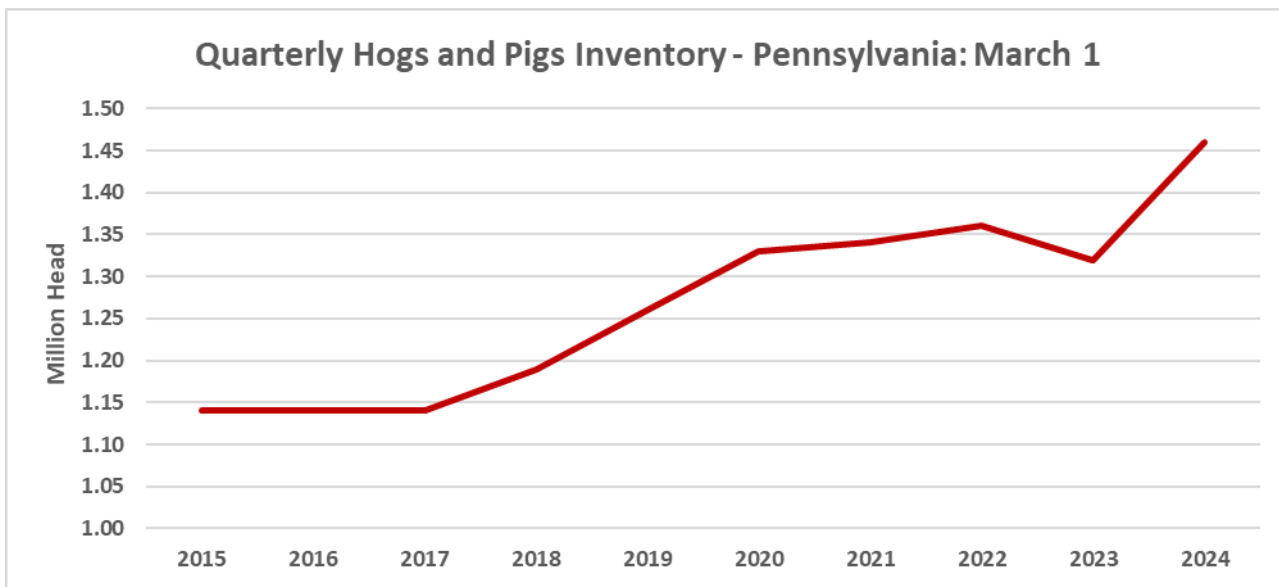
Pennsylvania hog inventory up 11 percent from 2023

Pennsylvania inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2024, was 1.46 million head. This was up 11 percent from March 1, 2023, but down 1 percent from December 1, 2023, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service, *Quarterly Hogs and Pigs* report.

Breeding inventory at 150 thousand head was up 11 percent from last year, but down 6 percent from the previous quarter.

Market hog inventory at 1.31 million head was up 11 percent from last year, but down 1 percent from last quarter.

The December 2023 to February 2024 pig crop at 543 thousand head was up 1 percent from 2023. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 46 thousand head, down 2 percent from 2023. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.80 for the December - February period, up 4 percent from last year.
