## Pennsylvania Hog Inventory Up 5 Percent

**Pennsylvania inventory** of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2015 is 1.16 million head, up 5 percent from June 1, 2014, and up 5 percent from March 1, 2015.

**Breeding inventory**, at 105 thousand head, is up 5 percent from last year, and up 5 percent from the previous quarter.

**Market hog inventory**, at 1.06 million head, is up 4 percent from last year, and up 3 percent from last quarter.

**The March 2014 - May 2015 pig crop**, at 505 thousand head, is up 2 percent from 2014. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 49 thousand head, up 2 percent from 2014. The average pigs saved per litter is 10.30 for the March - May period, unchanged from last year.
