## **Pennsylvania 2014 Annual Milk Production Up 1.2 Percent from 2013**

**The annual production of milk** for Pennsylvania during 2014 was 10.7 million pounds, 1.2 percent above 2013, according to King Whetstone, Director of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office. Revisions to 2013 production increased the annual total 13 million pounds.

**Production per cow** in Pennsylvania averaged 20,157 pounds for 2014, 360 pounds above 2013.

**The average number of milk cows on farms** in Pennsylvania during 2014 was 530 thousand head down 3 thousand head from 2013.
