## Pennsylvania Grain Stocks

HARRISBURG, PA--- Pennsylvania's **corn** stored in all positions on June 1, 2015 was 48.1 million bushels, up 20 percent from last year's level of 40.1 million bushels, according to King Whetstone, Director of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office. On-farm corn stocks amounted to 41.0 million bushels compared to the 33.0 million bushels in June 2014. Off-farm stocks were 7. million bushels.

**Wheat** stored off farms totaled 4.72 million bushels, up from last year's total of 4.40 million bushels. **Soybeans** stored off farms totaled 2.18 million bushels, up 11 percent. **Oats** stored in all positions were 1.19 million bushels, 285 thousand bushels off farm and 900 thousand bushels on farm. **Barley** stored off farms was 226 thousand bushels.

For the **United States**, **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 4.45 billion bushels, up 15 percent from June 1, 2014. Of the total stocks, 2.28 billion bushels are stored on farms, up 22 percent from a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 2.17 billion bushels, are up 9 percent from a year ago. The March - May 2015 indicated disappearance is 3.30 billion bushels, compared with 3.16 billion bushels during the same period last year.

**Soybeans** stored in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 625 million bushels, up 54 percent from June 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 246 million bushels, up 126 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 379 million bushels, are up 28 percent from a year ago. Indicated disappearance for the March - May 2015 quarter totaled 701 million bushels, up 19 percent from the same period a year earlier.

**Old crop all wheat** stored in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 753 million bushels, up 28 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks are estimated at 155 million bushels, up 60 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 597 million bushels, are up 21 percent from a year ago. The March - May 2015 indicated disappearance is 388 million bushels, down 17 percent from the same period a year earlier.
