Pennsylvania Grain Stocks

HARRISBURG, PA --- Pennsylvania's **corn** stored in all positions on September 1, 2015 was 20.7 million bushels, down 7 percent from last year's level of 22.2 million bushels, according to King Whetstone, Director of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Northeastern Regional Field Office. On-farm corn stocks amounted to 16.5 million bushels compared to the 19.0 million bushels in September 2014. Off-farm stocks were 4.2 million bushels.

Wheat stored off farms totaled 9.5 million bushels, up from last year's total of 8.0 million bushels. **Soybeans** stored off farms totaled 1.7 million bushels up from 793,000 bushels in 2014. **Oats** stored in all positions were 2.4 million bushels, with 557 thousand bushels off farm and 1.80 million bushels on farm. **Barley** stored off farms totaled 672 thousand bushels, down from last year's total of 684 thousand bushels.
