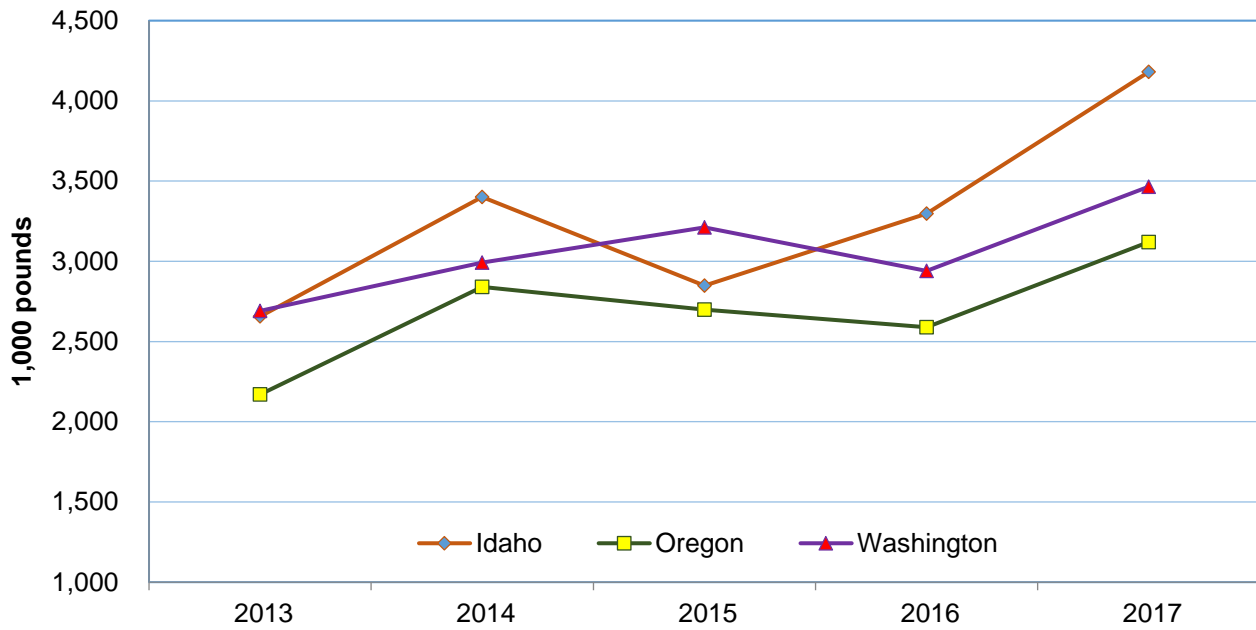

Honey Production—Idaho, Oregon, and Washington: 2013-2017



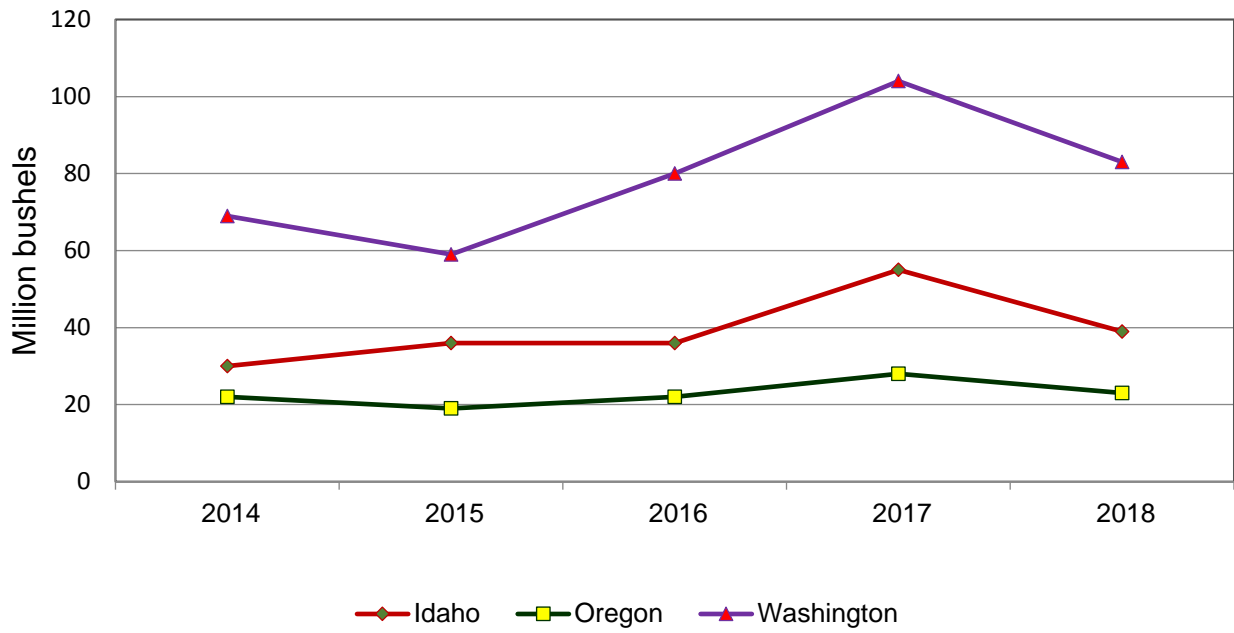

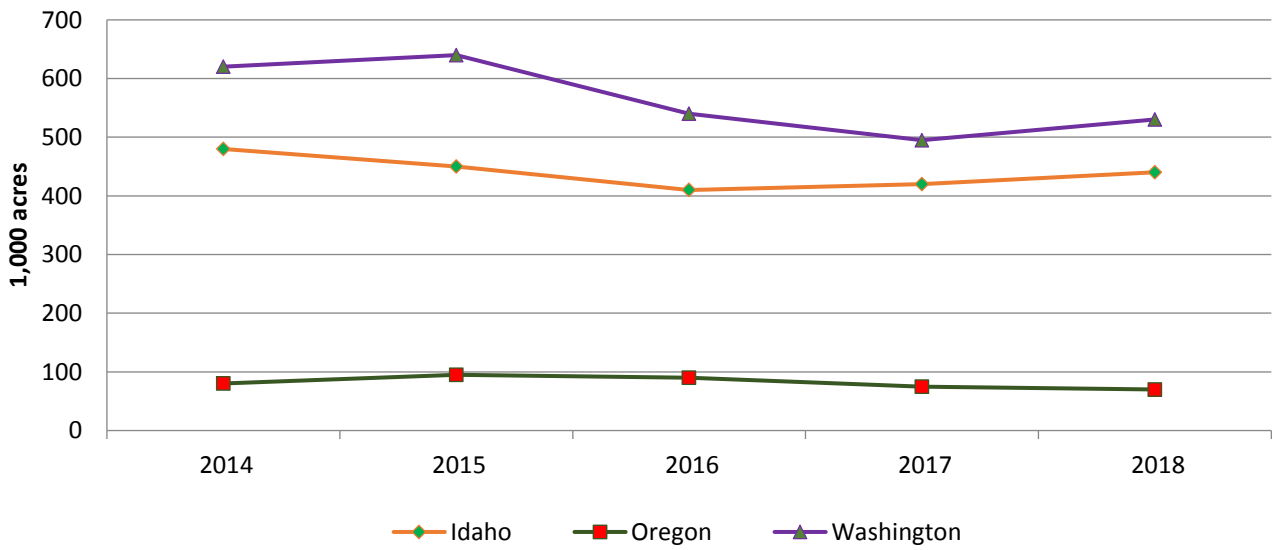

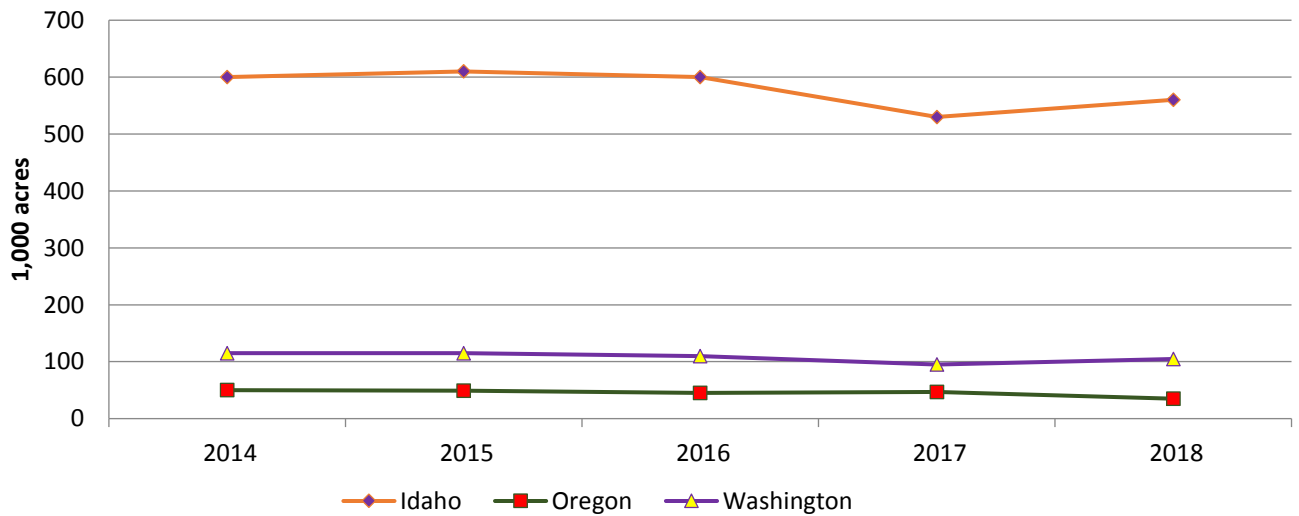

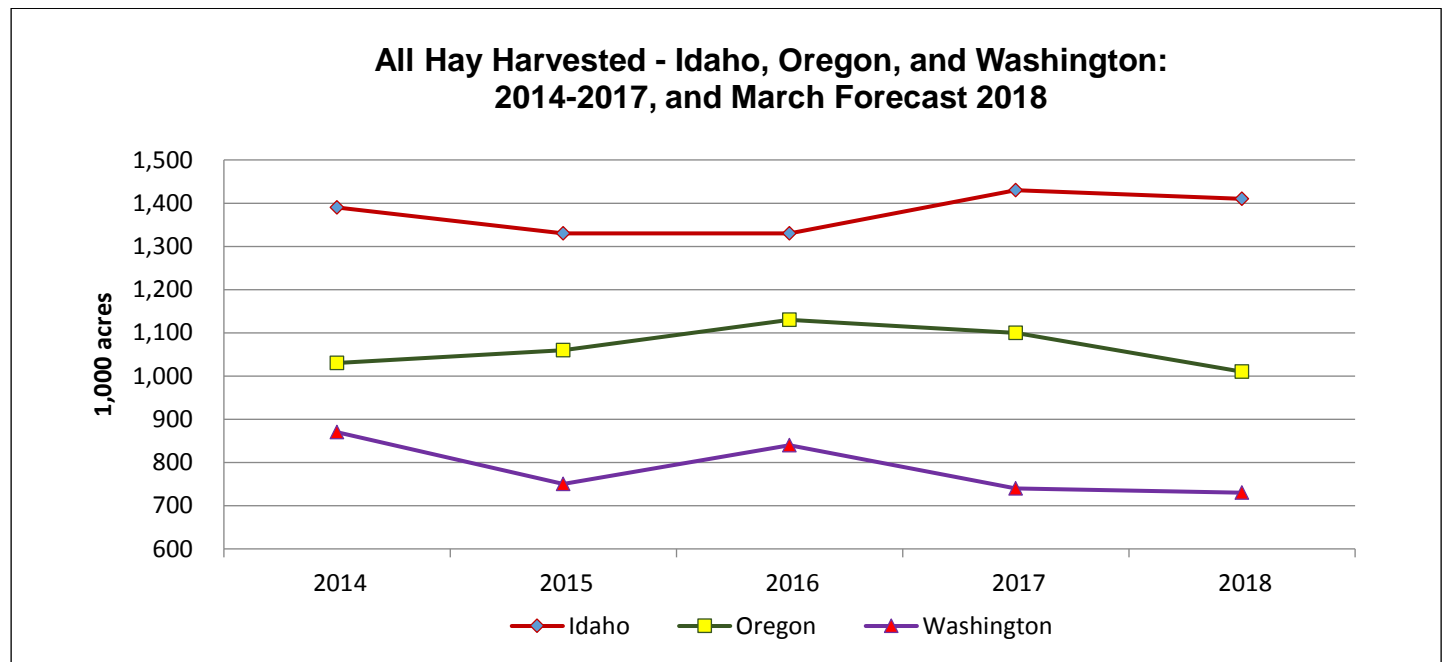
