March 1 Hop Stocks Down 4 Percent from Last Year



The inventory of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on March 1, 2013 totaled 115 million pounds, 4 percent less than March 1, 2012. Stocks held by brewers, at 53.0 million pounds, were unchanged from last year. Stocks held by growers and dealers on March 1, 2013 totaled 62.0 million pounds, down 7 percent from a year ago.

Note: Due to Sequestration, all releases of this report have been suspended through the end of the fiscal year on September 30, 2013.
