This report contains information on average prices and values of production for major field crops and many specialty crops. All prices in this report are marketing year average (MYA) prices, which are based on sales in the months comprising each state's marketing year. State value of production is computed by multiplying each state's price by its production.

United States Value of Production for Field and Miscellaneous Crops up 21 Percent in 2020

The value of the United States field and miscellaneous crops is estimated at \$159 billion in 2020, up 21 percent from 2019. Alabama production valued at \$955 million is up 9 percent from the previous year. Value of field and miscellaneous crops in Florida totals \$1.13 billion, a 1 percent decrease from 2019. Georgia crop value is estimated at \$2.04 billion, an increase of 8 percent from the previous year. Crop values in South Carolina total \$637 million, an 11 percent increase from 2019.
