
#### Wholesale Value of Floriculture Crops Up From 2015

The 2018 US wholesale value of floriculture crops is up 6 percent from the 2015 valuation. The total crop value at wholesale for all growers with \$10,000 or more in sales is estimated at \$4.63 billion for 2018, compared with \$4.37 billion for 2015. California and Florida account for 46 percent of the total value. The number of producers for 2018, at 6,386 is up 8 percent compared with the 2015 count.

The total wholesale value of floriculture crops sold by operations in the United States with \$100,000 or more of sales is \$4.60 billion for 2018, up 9 percent from the 2015 total. These operations account for 99 percent of the total value of \$4.62 billion in floriculture crops, but comprise only 44 percent of all producers. California accounts for 26 percent of the total wholesale value. Florida ranks second with 20 percent.

Florida total wholesale value of floriculture crops sold by operations with \$100,000 or more of sales, at \$939 million, is down 9 percent from 2015. Florida accounts for 63 percent of the US wholesale value of foliage plants value, 21 percent of propagative floriculture material and 17 percent of potted flowering plants value.


