United States utilized production in 2020 totaled 302 million pounds, up 18 percent from 2019. Georgia, which accounts for 47 percent of the Nation’s pecan production, shows a 23 percent increase in value of production for 2020. Favorable weather conditions aided Georgia producers this season and utilized production would be the highest since 2007.
