
### **US Winter Wheat Production Up 6 Percent from June Forecast**


Winter wheat production is forecast at 1.21 billion bushels, up 6 percent from the June 1 forecast and up 9 percent from 2022. As of July 1, the United States yield is forecast at 46.9 bushels per acre, up 2.0 bushels from last month but down 0.1 bushel from last year's average yield of 47.0 bushels per acre.

### Key findings for the Southern Region from July Crop Production

United States all flue-cured tobacco production is forecast at 285 million pounds, down 6 percent from 2022. Production in Georgia is forecast at 13.4 million pounds, up 7 percent from last year. Production in South Carolina is forecast at 10.8 million pounds, down 7 percent from last year.
