## **US Goats and Kids Inventory Down 2 Percent**

All goat inventory in the United States on January 1, 2024 totaled 2.47 million head, down 2 percent from 2023. Meat and all other goats totaled 1.95 million head, down 3 percent from the previous year. Milk goat inventory was 415,000 head, up 1 percent from the previous year. Alabama all goat inventory totaled 44,900 head, 6 percent below last year. In Florida, the all goat inventory totaled 55,300 head, 1 percent below 2023. Georgia all goat inventory totaled 58,900 head, down 9 percent from the previous year. In South Carolina, the all goat inventory was down 6 percent to 33,900 head.
