United States Poultry Value of Production and Sales Down 11 Percent

The United States combined value of production from broilers, eggs, turkeys, and the value of sales from chickens in 2020 was \$35.5 billion, down 11 percent from \$40.0 billion in 2019. Of the combined total, 61 percent was from broilers, 24 percent from eggs, 15 percent from turkeys, and less than 1 percent from chickens.

The value of broilers produced during 2020 was \$21.7 billion, down 23 percent from 2019. Values across the Southern Region were also down. In Georgia, the leading broiler state, the value of production was down 27 percent. Value in Alabama, the fourth largest broiler-producing state, was also down 21 percent. Florida value decreased by 18 percent and South Carolina decreased by 23 percent.

Nationally, the value of all egg production including hatching and market (table) eggs in 2020 was \$8.66 billion, up 18 percent from \$7.33 billion in 2019. Egg production totaled 112 billion eggs, down 1 percent from 113 billion eggs produced in 2019.

Broiler-type chicks hatched across the United States during 2020 totaled 9.87 billion, down slightly percent from 2019.

Placements of broiler chicks for meat production totaled 9.79 billion during the 53 week period ending January 2, 2021, up 1 percent from the 52 week period ending December 28, 2019. Egg-type chicks hatched during 2020 totaled 623 million, down 1 percent from 2019.

Georgia and Alabama ranked first and second in the nation, respectively, in broiler eggs set, broiler-type chicks hatched, and broiler chicks placed during the year. Combined, they account for more than 27 percent of the U.S. total in each category.
