United States Poultry Value of Production and Sales Up 67 Percent

The United States combined value of production from broilers, eggs, turkeys, and the value of sales from chickens in 2022 was \$77.0 billion, up 67 percent from \$46.1 billion in 2021. Of the combined total, 66 percent was from broilers, 25 percent from eggs, 9 percent from turkeys, and less than 1 percent from chickens.

The value of broilers produced during 2022 was \$50.4 billion, up 60 percent from 2021. The total number of broilers produced in 2022 was 9.17 billion, up slightly from 2021. The total amount of live weight broilers produced in 2022 was 59.3 billion pounds, up slightly from 2021.

Nationally, the value of sales from chickens (excluding broilers) in 2022 was \$74.7 million, up 401 percent from \$14.9 million a year ago. The number of chickens sold in 2022 totaled 168 million, down 8 percent from the total sold during the previous year. Egg production in 2022, including hatching and market (table) eggs, totaled 110 billion eggs. The value of all egg production was \$19.4 billion, up 122 percent from \$8.71 billion in 2021.



United States Broiler Placements Up 2 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched across the United States during 2022 totaled 10.0 billion, up 1 percent from 2021. Placements of broiler chicks for meat production totaled 9.78 billion during the 52 week period ending December 31, 2022, up 2 percent from the 52 week period ending January 1, 2022. Egg-type chicks hatched during 2022 totaled 631 million, up slightly from 2021.
