Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Down 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 237 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 6, 2024, down 1 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.8 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Hatcheries in Alabama set 34.0 million eggs during the week ending January 6, 2024, down 1 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in Georgia set 35.1 million eggs during the same week, down 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down Slightly

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 6, 2024, down slightly from a year ago.

Broiler growers in Alabama placed 23.1 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 6, 2024, down 4 percent from a year ago. Placements in Georgia totaled 27.3 million chicks, down 4 percent from a year ago.
