## SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. January 24, 2022** - For the week ending January 23, 2022, topsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 35% short, 52% adequate, and 1% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 15% very short, 38% short, 46% adequate, and 1% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 3% very poor, 6% poor, 60% fair, 30% good, and 1% excellent.

The next report is currently scheduled to be issued February 22, 2022 but may change due to the federal holiday on February 21<sup>st</sup>.
