SOUTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2018 GRAIN STOCKS

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. June 29, 2018 -- South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2018 totaled 260 million bushels, down 8 percent from 2017, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 165 million bushels are stored on farms, down 8 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 94.7 million bushels, are down 7 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 53.8 million bushels, up 20 percent from last year. Onfarm stocks of 23.0 million bushels are up 31 percent from a year ago and off-farm stocks, at 30.8 million bushels, are up 12 percent from 2017.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 26.1 million bushels, down 49 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 9.20 million bushels are down 59 percent from 2017 and off-farm stocks of 16.9 million bushels are down 41 percent from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 1.11 million bushels, down 64 percent from June 2017.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 1.09 million bushels, down 54 percent from last year. Onfarm stocks of 630,000 bushels are down 55 percent from 2017. Off-farm stocks of 459,000 bushels are down 53 percent from last year.
