SOUTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2019 GRAIN STOCKS

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. March 29, 2019 - South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2019 totaled 464 million bushels, down 7 percent from 2018, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 345 million bushels are stored on farms, up 13 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 119 million bushels, are down 39 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 158 million bushels, up 66 percent from last year. Onfarm stocks of 86.0 million bushels are up 132 percent from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 71.8 million bushels, are up 23 percent from 2018.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 57.2 million bushels, up 15 percent from a year ago. Onfarm stocks of 24.5 million bushels are up 44 percent from 2018, but off-farm stocks of 32.7 million bushels are down slightly from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 3.00 million bushels, up 114 percent from March 2018.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 3.19 million bushels, up 21 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 2.30 million bushels are up 35 percent from 2018. Off-farm stocks of 887,000 bushels are down 6 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 274,000, up from 5,000 in March 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 270,000 bushels. Off-farm stocks of 4,000 bushels, are down 20 percent from 2018.
