SOUTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2019 GRAIN STOCKS

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. June 28, 2019 - South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2019 totaled 268 million bushels, up 3 percent from 2018, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 210 million bushels are stored on farms, up 27 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 57.5 million bushels, are down 39 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 100.0 million bushels, up 86 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 59.0 million bushels are up 157 percent from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 41.0 million bushels, are up 33 percent from 2018.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 39.1 million bushels, up 50 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 17.0 million bushels are up 85 percent from 2018, and off-farm stocks of 22.1 million bushels are up 31 percent from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 1.71 million bushels, up 54 percent from June 2018.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 2.26 million bushels, up 108 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 1.50 million bushels are up 138 percent from 2018. Off-farm stocks of 763,000 bushels are up 66 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 177,000 bushels. On-farm stocks totaled 170,000 bushels and off-farm stocks of 7,000 were equal to 2018.
