SOUTH DAKOTA SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 GRAIN STOCKS

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. September 30, 2019 - South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2019 totaled 120 million bushels, up 3 percent from 2018, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 63.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 13 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 57.2 million bushels, are down 7 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 58.3 million bushels, up 176 percent from last year. Onfarm stocks are 26.0 million bushels, up 271 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 32.3 million bushels, are up 129 percent from 2018.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 83.6 million bushels, down 5 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 44.0 million bushels are up 9 percent from 2018, while off-farm stocks of 39.6 million bushels are down 16 percent from last year.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 5.69 million bushels, down 16 percent from last year. Onfarm stocks of 4.50 million bushels are down 8 percent from 2018. Off-farm stocks of 1.19 million bushels are down 35 percent from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 286,000 bushels. On-farm stocks totaled 280,000 bushels. Off-farm stocks totaled 6,000 bushels, up 20 percent from 2018.
