SOUTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2020 GRAIN STOCKS

SIoux FALLS, S.D. June 30, 2020 - South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2020 totaled 275 million bushels, up 3% from 2019, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 195 million bushels are stored on farms, down 7% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 79.7 million bushels, are up 39% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 74.4 million bushels, down 26% from last year. On-farm stocks of 40.0 million bushels are down 32% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 34.4 million bushels, are down 16% from 2019.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 45.8 million bushels, up 17% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 18.0 million bushels are up 6% from 2019, and off-farm stocks of 27.8 million bushels are up 26% from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 1.77 million bushels, up 4% from June 2019.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 2.28 million bushels, up 1% from last year. On-farm stocks of 1.30 million bushels are down 13% from 2019. Off-farm stocks of 981,000 bushels are up 29% from last year.

Barley on-farm stocks totaled 70,000 bushels, down 59% from June 2019.
