SOUTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES

SIOUX FALLS, SD, January 31, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat in January averaged \$6.00 per bushel, down 20 cents from last month according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The preliminary January spring wheat price, at \$6.25, is down 34 cents from last month.

The preliminary January oats price was not published due to insufficient number of reports to establish an estimate.

The preliminary January corn price, at \$3.90, is down 6 cents from last month.

The preliminary January soybean price, at \$12.50, is down 20 cents from last month.

The preliminary January price for all sunflower is \$17.80, down 30 cents from last month.

The January alfalfa price, at \$137.00 per ton, is down \$8.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$129.00, is up \$12.00 from last month.
