## **SOUTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES**

SIOUX FALLS, SD, March 28, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat in March averaged \$6.85 per bushel, up 43 cents from last month according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The preliminary March spring wheat price, at \$7.08, is up 29 cents from last month.

The preliminary March oats price, at \$3.75, is up 13 cents from the last month.

The preliminary March corn price, at \$4.15, is up 5 cents from last month.

The preliminary March soybean price, at \$12.90, is up 20 cents from last month.

The preliminary March price for all sunflowers is \$20.20, up \$1.40 from last month.

The March alfalfa price, at \$127.00 per ton, is down \$4.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$100.00, is down \$5.00 from last month.
