SOUTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES

SIOUX FALLS, SD, May 30, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat in May averaged \$7.09 per bushel, up 36 cents from last month according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The preliminary May spring wheat price, at \$7.02, is down 14 cents from last month.

The preliminary May oats price, at \$3.79, is up 1 cent from the last month.

The preliminary May corn price, at \$4.21, is up 2 cents from last month.

The preliminary May soybean price, at \$14.10, is up 40 cents from last month.

The preliminary May price for all sunflowers is \$20.80, up 80 cents from last month.

The May alfalfa price, at \$139.00 per ton, is up \$6.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$97.00, is down \$4.00 from last month.
