SOUTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES

SIOUX FALLS, SD, July 31, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat in July averaged \$5.75 per bushel, down 91 cents from last month according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The preliminary July spring wheat price, at \$6.30, is down 61 cents from last month.

The preliminary July oats price, at \$3.08, is down 65 cents from the last month.

The preliminary July corn price, at \$3.21, is down 85 cents from last month.

The preliminary July soybean price, at \$12.40, is down \$1.50 from last month.

The preliminary July price for all sunflowers is \$19.50, down \$1.30 from last month.

The July alfalfa price, at \$118.00 per ton, is down \$17.00 from last month. The other hay price, at \$109.00, is up \$18.00 from last month.
