SOUTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL PRICES

SIOUX FALLS, SD, November 26, 2014 -- Preliminary prices received by farmers for winter wheat in November averaged \$5.55 per bushel, is up 4 cents from last month according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The preliminary November spring wheat price, at \$5.33, is up 9 cents from last month.

The preliminary November oat price, at \$3.04, is up 14 cents from the last month.

The preliminary November corn price, at \$3.18, is up 9 cents from last month.

The preliminary November soybean price, at \$9.55, is up 31 cents from last month.

The preliminary November price for all sunflower, at \$17.00, is down \$4.10 from last month.

The November alfalfa hay price, at \$117.00 per ton, is unchanged from last month. The other hay price, at \$90.00, is unchanged from last month.
