## SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

SIoux FALLS, SD, July 11, 2014 -- Based on July 1 conditions, South Dakota's 2014 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 53.8 million bushels, up 10 percent from the June 1 forecast, and up 106 percent from last year's crop, according to the USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 46 bushels per acre, up 7 bushels from last year. Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 1.17 million acres, up 75 percent from last year. This would be 90 percent of planted acres.

**Other spring wheat** production is forecast at 54.6 million bushels, up 7 percent from last year. The yield, forecast at 43 bushels per acre is down 1 bushel from last year's yield. Acres intended for harvest, at 1.27 million, are up 9 percent from 2013.

**Oat** production, at 8.80 million bushels, is down 5 percent from last year. The yield is forecast at 80 bushels, up 3 bushels from last year's yield. Expected area to be harvested for grain, at 110,000 acres, is down 8 percent from 2013.
