SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

SIoux FALLS, SD, June 10, 2015 -- Based on June 1 conditions, South Dakota's 2015 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 45.1 million bushels, down 24 percent from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 41 bushels per acre, down 14 bushels from last year.

Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 1.10 million acres, is up 2 percent from last year. This would be 77 percent of planted acres.
