SOUTH DAKOTA GRAIN STOCKS

Sioux Falls, SD – Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 293 million bushels, up 20 percent from June 1, 2015, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 205 million bushels are stored on farms, up 24 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 88.0 million bushels, are up 11 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 45.4 million bushels, up 83 percent from last year. On-farm stocks are 25.0 million bushels, up 72 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 20.4 million bushels, are up 99 percent from 2015.

All wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 47.2 million bushels, up 49 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 18.0 million bushels are up 29 percent from 2015. Off-farm stocks of 29.2 million bushels are up 66 percent from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks on June 1, 2016 totaled 1.30 million bushels, up 265 percent from June 2015.

Oats stored in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 4.20 million bushels, up 63 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 3.00 million bushels are up 88 percent from 2015. Off-farm stocks of 1.20 bushels are up 23 percent from last year.

Barley on-farm stocks on June 1, 2016, totaled 120,000 bushels, down 50 percent from last year.
