SOUTH DAKOTA GRAIN STOCKS

Sioux Falls, SD – Corn stocks in all positions on September 1, 2016 totaled 104 million bushels, up 12 percent from September 1, 2015, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 53.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 18 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 50.9 million bushels, are up 7 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 9.46 million bushels, up 20 percent from last year. On-farm stocks are 3.70 million bushels, up 48 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 5.76 million bushels, are up 7 percent from 2015.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 129 million bushels, up 32 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 66.0 million bushels are up 29 percent from 2015. Off-farm stocks of 62.9 million bushels are up 34 percent from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 630,000 bushels, up from 83,000 bushels in 2015.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 6.86 million bushels, down 44 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 5.20 million bushels are down 35 percent from 2015. Off-farm stocks of 1.66 million bushels are down 61 percent from last year.
