SOUTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

SIOUX FALLS, SD, March 19, 2014 – Milk production in South Dakota during February 2014 totaled 156 million pounds, up two percent from February 2013, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows, at 95,000 head, was up 3,000 head from last year. Milk production per cow averaged 1,640 pounds.
